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Pay/Prepay/Charge Policy Van ISD 2020-2021

Pay/Prepay:

Students/District Employees may pay for their meals by the day, week, month, or year. Write the student's first and last name on all checks.

Payments/Prepayments may be made at the following locations: Any cafeteria meal line or the Child Nutrition Director's office between the hours of: 7:30 am -2:00 pm (school days), on-line service (Lunch Money Now), or by mail to:

Van ISD, Child Nutrition Department, P.O. Box 697, Van, TX 75790.

Charge Policy:

In efforts to meet Federal Child Nutrition requirements the District established the local school meal charge policy. **The Van ISD School Board approved this policy.**

A student may charge no more than 4 days, worth of meals. After which, they would receive an alternate meal (fruit, vegetables, milk, and bread, of the day's menu) at no charge.

No ala carte items may be charged, at anytime.

District Employees may charge no more than 4 days worth of meals. No ala carte items may be charged at anytime.

The district, or the cafeteria, will attempt to contact the parent/guardian of any student with a negative balance; at least, the day before the student will receive the alternate meal.

The district will not charge a fee or interest in connection with a negative meal balance. Negative meal balances should be paid, as soon as possible, or by the last day of the school year.

Inactive Positive Accounts: If you withdraw from the district, with a positive meal balance, you must request a refund, before June 20th, of that school year. The request may be made: at the time of withdrawal, or by phone, letter or email. (903) 963-5256; Child Nutrition Dept P.O. Box 697 Van TX 75790; penny.dutton@vanisd.org Non-request of a refund will be considered as an approval for these funds to be used in applying the positive balances to any other negative student balances.

Household Positive Accounts: (End of Year) If a student with a positive account has siblings with negative accounts the positive funds will be redistributed to the negative accounts of the household.
