



SCHOOL BUS PROTOCOLS FOR COVID PREVENTION

In order to make sure we have a safe and secure environment for our students who ride the bus, the following procedures will be put into place at the start of school and continue until further notice:

- The student needs to check their temperature prior to coming to the bus stop each morning. If the student is running a fever of 100° or higher, the student should be kept at home until fever free for 24 hours without the use of medications (i.e. aspirin, Tylenol, etc.)
- All bus riders will be required to wear facemasks while on the bus.
- As riders enter the bus, they will apply hand sanitizer that will be mounted at the entrance door.
- Strict adherence to all bus rules from the bus driver and/or monitor must be followed.
- All students exiting the bus will be checked for fever by school personnel before being allowed into their campus.
- Campus personnel will follow campus protocol concerning those students who have fever.
